Parents, please, the group is for admin only. Please do not reply or comment on the group. Should you not have the D6 loaded on your phone, you are welcome to come to the school and we will download it for you. It is free! Please ensure you have access to either of these in order for you to see the weekly circulars and know what is going on for the week.

Cellphones: It is against our school policy to bring cellphones to school. Should it be absolutely necessary that your child needs to have his/her cellphone a school, a letter needs to be written to the Governing Body requesting permission. Should permission be granted, the cellphone must be handed in to the office at the start of the day and collected at the end of the day. Parents, please check your children’s cellphones regularly. Should your child be found to have a cellphone at school, it will be confiscated and parents may collect it at the end of the term.
